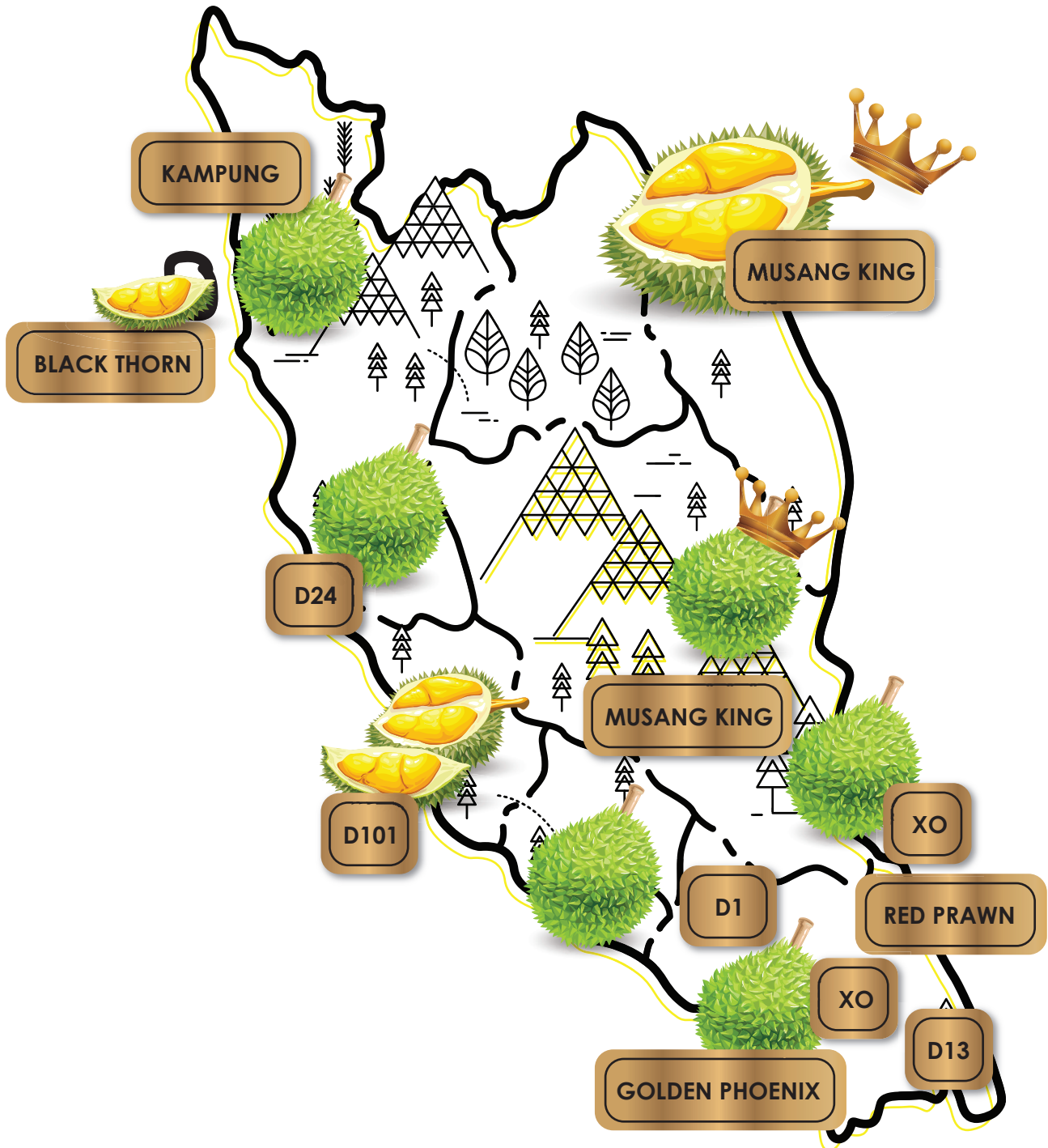

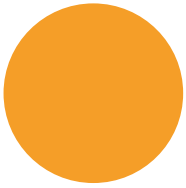

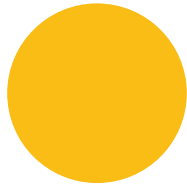


# Yummy Shades Of Yellow

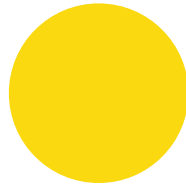
You can identify a durian by the colour of its flesh. The varieties found in Malaysia are mostly yellow or cream, with a few bordering on orange-red.



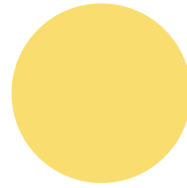

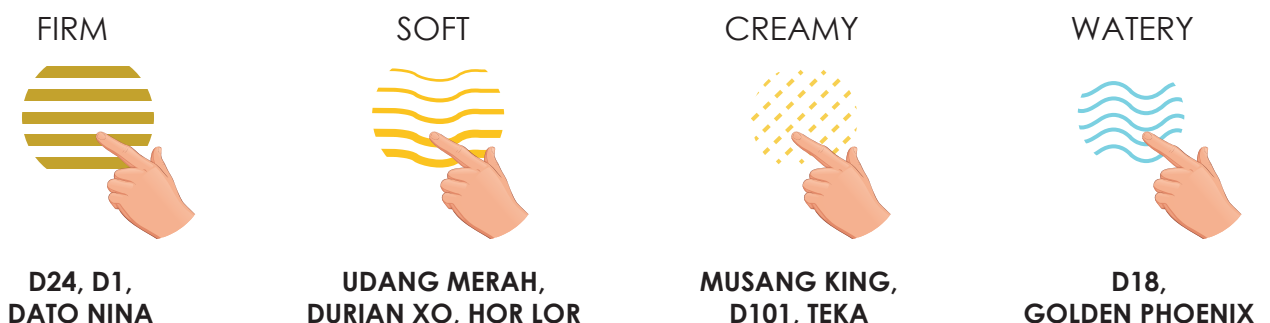
# MOUTH-WATERING GOODNESS
